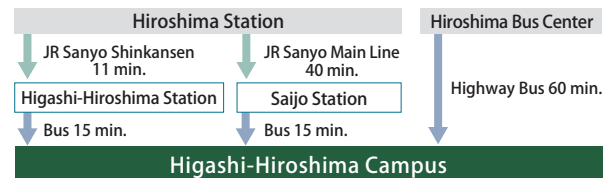
## International Student Enrollment
